The maximum amount awarded to a recipient during enrollment at Richmond is \$10,000 over a period no longer than three years. The scholarship committee will begin reviewing applications immediately for scholarships to be awarded this coming fall semester. The next program deadline for applications is May 1. Please be aware that the scholarship committee reserves the right to conduct interviews of applicants as deemed appropriate.
