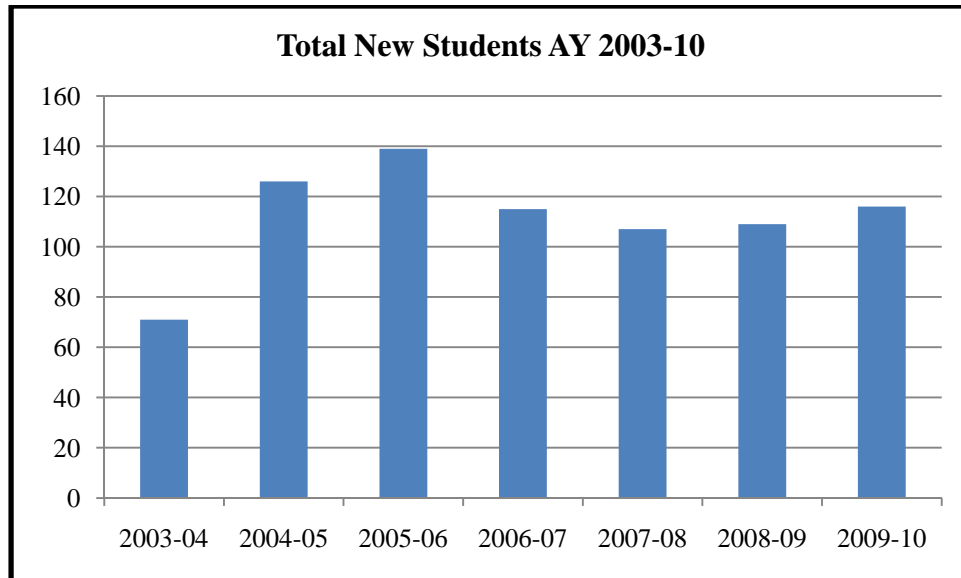

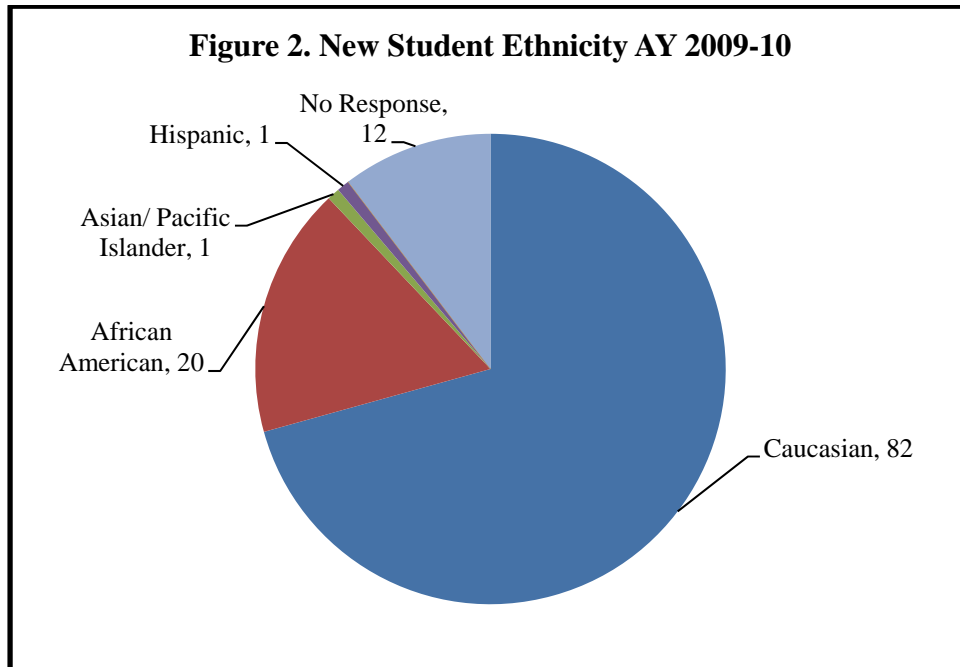

Figure 3. New Student Degree Program AY 2009-10

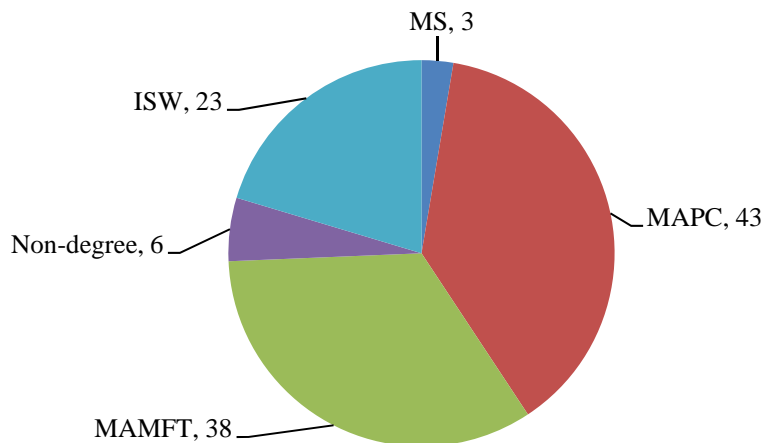

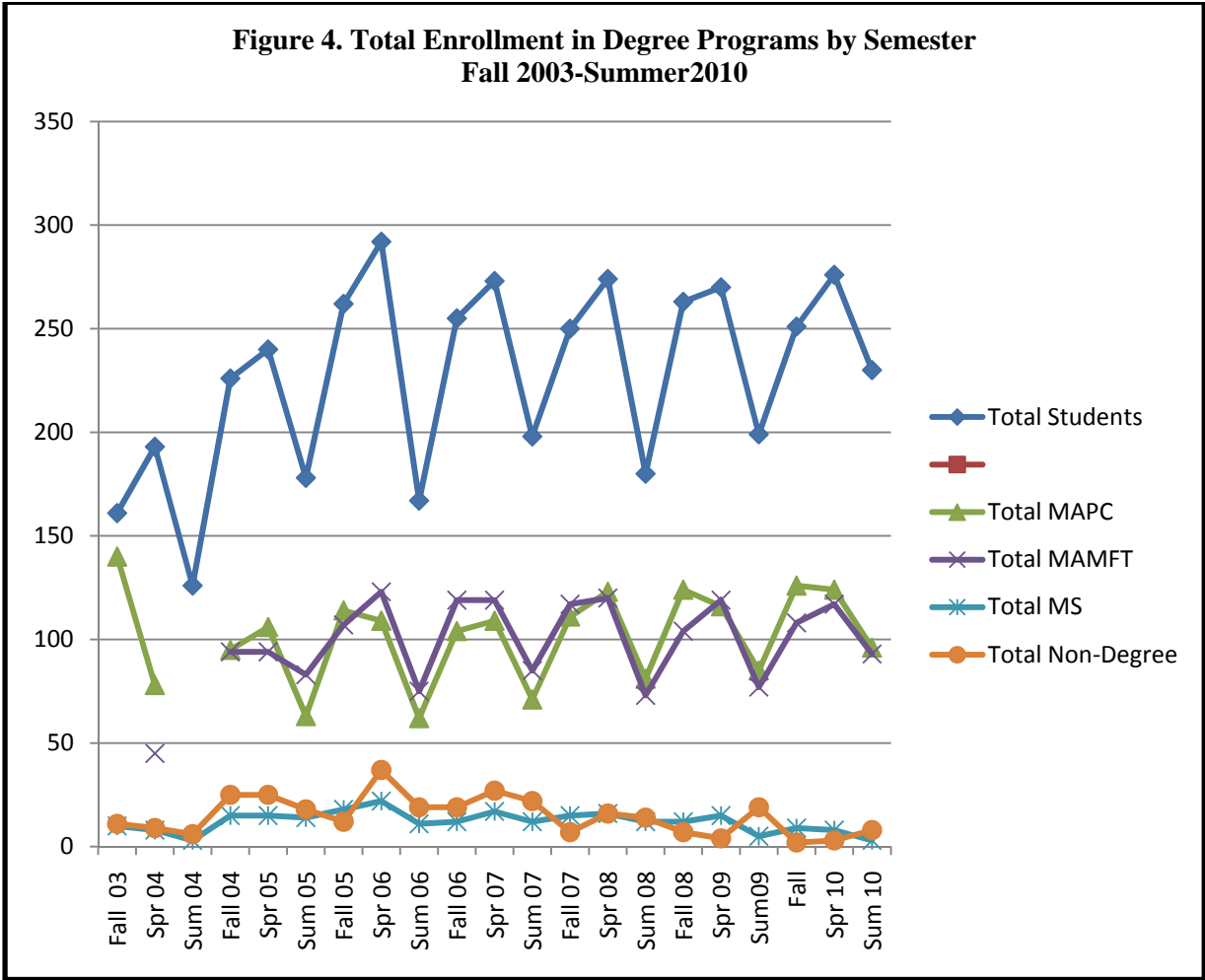

Collections Management

The Richmond libraries received additional funding (\$35,000) to enhance the collections in support of CACREP accreditation and in support of a potential new PhD program. This funding is expected to continue until the collections have reached a level that will fully support the proposed Doctoral program. Purchasing choices to support these programs are being systematically made through a project comparing the Richmond collections with the collections of libraries that support Doctoral level Psychology programs. Due to the current economy and budgetary concerns, purchasing was held to a minimum with this funding. During the 09/10 FY, an approximate \$4,000.00 was spent on this project specifically. This left \$31,000.00 to roll over and be added to the additional \$35,000.00 in the next FY (if it was not used for other purposes).

Library Instruction

During 09/10, a total of 9 Classroom Library Instruction sessions were performed by library faculty.

Library IT

During 09/10, thin client terminals were added to both libraries. There are currently 5 public thin client terminals in the Atlanta Library and 6 public thin client terminals in the Chattanooga Library (along with 2 staff workstations).

Both libraries added wireless printing via the wireless networks on both campuses, to enhance students work with their personal laptops.
